Kramden Institute, a Durham-based non-profit organization, has been working since 2003 to bridge the digital divide by providing technology tools and training. As a computer refurbisher, the organization collects thousands of devices each year, restores them, and distributes them back into the community. To date more than 48,000 computers have been distributed to students and adults across North Carolina. More than 9,000 individuals have participated in educational and training programs since they began in 2014.

### **Position Overview**

Kramden is looking for an energetic and engaging technology instructor to join our team. Kramden has a long history of being an innovative leader in providing digital inclusion programs to communities in need. We are looking for an educator with a passion for technology and a desire to bring equity to all through education and training. This Technology Educator will be a key member of our program team and will teach a wide variety of classes to a client population that ranges from elementary aged students to senior adults. Work for this position will take place primarily at the Kramden office in Durham, NC with some classes taking place at partner locations throughout the Triangle.

#### *Technology Education*

- Utilize existing curriculum to prepare and teach classes. Classes may include but are not limited to:
  - Basic digital literacy skills for adults (taught both in person and online),
  - Summer camps (digital creativity, game design, PC build, coding basics, electronics, etc.)
  - Afterschool programs
  - Technology workshops for adults and youth
- Work with the Educator Manager to create new and innovative curriculum and class offerings
- Plan and organize instruction in ways that maximize student learning
- Maintain accurate attendance and participation documentation for each course offered at Kramden
- Develop strong relationships with clients and create individual learning plans
- Train community members on how to deliver computer basics training (train-the-trainer model)
- Create and update asset inventories of digital inclusion resources in communities across North Carolina

#### *Administrative Support*

- Assist with volunteer events, computers distributions, and front office operations as needed
- Utilize Customer Relationship Management (CRM) software to track and program participants and create methods for increased client engagement

- Ability to work some evenings and occasional weekends
- A working knowledge of computer technology, including operating systems, file structure, office programs, and the internet
- Experience with multiple operating systems and an openness to learn new software
- Excellent verbal communication skills with ability to present ideas and information clearly
- Experience teaching or working with students of all ages
- Commitment to working with students from differing backgrounds and of varying levels of ability
- Attention to detail and outstanding organizational skills
